

CHAMPAGNE & PROSECCO

Prosecco DOC Brut (Borgo del Col Alto, Veneto ~ Italy) €32.00

This Prosecco has a lively and persistent effervescence, with a clear and pale yellow hue. It is marked by fruity and slightly floral aromas, with delicate notes of green apple and honey. On the palate, it showcases a well-balanced structure with a delicate mouthfeel, making for a refreshing and elegant experience.

Franciacorta, Cuvée Royal (Marchese Antinori, Calino ~ Italy) €60.00

A light yellow in colour with a creamy bubbling and an elegant, persistent sparkle. The aromas recall white peaches, bread crusts, and yeast. The notable balance and liveliness are typical of a well-made Brut.

Moët Brut Imperial 37.5cl €70.00 (Moët et Chandon, Champagne ~ France) 75cl €115.00

This Champagne displays a clear, very pale straw hue with small, active bubbles. The bouquet is subtle, suggesting delicate floral notes, hints of vanilla and grapefruit, and a yeastiness. On the palate, it showcases a light and mild mouthfeel, with flavours that evoke ripe fruit, a hint of sweetness, and subtle notes of toast, bread dough, and yeast. The excellent balance between acidity and sweetness makes for a slightly tart yet pleasant experience.

Moët Ice Imperial (Moët et Chandon, Champagne ~ France) €135.00

A new Champagne experience combining fun, fresh and free sensations while remaining true to the Moët & Chandon style, a style distinguished by its bright fruitiness, its seductive palate and its elegant maturity.

Moët Brut Imperial Rose (Moët et Chandon, Champagne ~ France) €140.00

This is a spontaneous, radiant, romantic expression of the Moët & Chandon style, a style distinguished by its bright fruitiness, its seductive palate and its elegant maturity.

Dom Perignon (Moët et Chandon, Champagne ~ France) €450.00

This wine exhibits a delicate mineral flavour, complemented by subtle sweet spice, prominent citrus aromas, and a distinctive oyster water note. On the palate, it showcases an unctuous texture, with lots of pencil lead and accompanied by hints of lemon pith, and a coating of honey and orange. The wine also features a lovely musky element. A stunning Champagne.

Cuvée Cristal (Louis Roederer, Champagne ~ France) €630.00

This vivid Champagne has an upfront and linear definition thanks to its sharp rapier-like acidity. The delicate flavours of juicy black cherry and mandarin orange mingle with notes of raw almond, anise and cardamom spice as well as a touch of honeycomb which all unfurl and expand on the fine, creamy palate.

WHITE WINE

Malta

Medina Chardonnay 37.5cl €15.00 Girgentina D.O.K 75cl €20.00 (Delicata, Paola)

Sun-kissed Girgentina grapes from bush-trained, native old vines have been skilfully blended into noble Chardonnay bunches to create a full-bodied and fruity wine, giving the wine a unique regional expression. This light, crisp, unoaked dry wine allures with subtle flowery scents and refreshing flavours of green apple characteristic of Girgentina's delicateness.

Grand Vin De Hauteville Viognier, 37.5cl €26.00 D.O.K Superior 75cl €38.00 (Delicata, Paola)

This full-flavoured, dry white wine is made from the designer grape Viognier. Unoaked, it refreshingly delights the senses with its floral and peachy aroma. It is ripe on the palate, yet has famously rich apricot flavours to offer. The wine is blossom-scented with exotic fruits and offers an aromatic sensory experience

Italy

Grillo DOC Organic (VivaBio Colomba Bianca, Sicily) €24.00

This straw-yellow wine with brilliant greenish hues has a delicate bouquet of tropical fruits, melon, and pineapple with hints of white flowers. It has a harmonious and elegant taste, with balanced acidity and pairs well with starters, char-grilled or fried shellfish, white meats, and Asian cuisine.

Pinot Grigio 'Ventiterre' (Zonin, Veneto) €25.00

Straw-yellow colour with subtle green reflections, this wine is delicately fruity and relatively full, offering a refined and finesse aroma. It is lightly dry yet extremely fresh, a delicious reminder of the original grape. Its light and elegant structure makes this an unusually refined and aristocratic wine.

Pecorino 'Terre di Chieti' (Cantine Tombacco, Abruzzo) €31.00

At entry this is an important wine, well-structured with good acidity. Excellent matching with fish-based starter dishes, ideal with all grilled fish and it also goes well with not too complex white meat recipes.

Gavi di Gavi (Palladino, Piemonte) €38.00

This wine is straw-yellow with greenish tinges and offers an intense characteristic and a delicate aroma, with hints of bitter almonds. It has a dry, clean taste with harmonious acidity recalling an almond flavour, balancing well between nose and taste.

Anthilia DOC (Donnafugata, Sicily) €39.00

Brilliant straw yellow, Anthilia has a fresh and fragrant bouquet with fruity notes of apples, white-fleshed peaches and citrus peel, as well as hints of Mediterranean scrub. On the palate we find the evident fruity note again, refreshed by agreeable sapidity.

Falanghina del Sannio (Mastroberardino, Campania) €39.00

Pale lemon-green. Aromas of ripe pineapple, citrus fruits and white flowers. Notes of honeysuckle and toasted almond on the palate are lifted by lively acidity. Pair with rich seafood dishes, anchovy-based sauces or flavorful, raw ceviche.

France

Muscadet Sèvre et Maine (Barton & Guestier, Loire) €29.00

This wine has a pale straw-yellow colour and an expressive nose that features aromas of pear and white peach, complemented by flattering subtle notes of pineapple. On the palate, it is fresh and crisp with intense mouth flavours and a refreshing aftertaste.

Reserve Sauvignon Blanc – Sémillon (Chateau Lamothe Vincent, Bordeaux) €32.00

This wine boasts a pale lemon colour with green tints and offers a bouquet of pineapple, apricot, exotic fruits, grapefruit, citrus, and mineral aromas and flavours.

Chablis (Louis Moreau, Burgundy) €57.00

The Domaine Louis Moreau Chablis is fruity and vivid, with floral notes and hints of apple and pear. Bright acidity, with minerality and a palate balanced by roundness and finesse.

Sancerre 'Terre de Brune' (Calvet, Loire) €60.00

This wine presents flinty, stoney aromas and exhibits a crisp and zesty character with tangy acidity. It showcases notes of elderflower and minerality both on the nose and palate.

Germany

Blue Nun Liebfraumilch (H. Sichel & Sohne, Rheingau) €25.00

Aromatic, fruity, and racy, it unveils honeysuckle and mandarin aromas before revealing delicate, low-alcohol German white wine with a finely balanced residual sweetness.

Spain

Rioja Blanco (LAN, Viura) €29.00

This wine has a pale straw yellow colour. On the nose it is fruity with notes of apple, banana, and aromatic herbs. The palate is fresh with a marked acidity and the finish is elegant and long.

Chile

Sauvignon Blanc 'Classic Reserva' (Montes – Casablanca Valley) €33.00

The intense and very cheerful nose offers aromas of lime and grapefruit accompanied by attractive notes of fresh pineapple, passion fruit, and orange blossom, while a light touch of green chili lends complexity to the coastal aromatic profile.

South Africa

Chenin Blanc (Arabella, Robertson) €22.00

This wine displays a beautiful yellow colour with lime green undertones. On the nose, it offers a delightful bouquet of guava with subtle notes of fresh straw. The palate is rich and full, with a lively and racy character, culminating in a great finish.

Australia

Pinot Grigio 'All Rounder' (Ian Botham, South Eastern Australia) €29.00

Attractive, pale straw with gold hues. All the classic hallmarks of Pinot Grigio are present in this wine. This is a medium bodied wine with delicate and elegant flavours of pear and apple which are harmoniously blended with hints of citrus fruit flavours.



RED WINE

Malta

Medina Syrah DOK 37.5cl €15.00
(Delicata, Paola) 75cl €20.00

The balminess and Maltese sunshine blessing Delicata's family-run vineyards shine through in this wine's intense plum and mulberry flavours. Made from hand-picked Syrah bunches, this unoaked and fruit-packed ruby-red dry wine is medium to full bodied. It has a smooth finish and shows real regional character.

Grand Vin de Hauteville
Cabernet Sauvignon, D.O.K Superior 37.5cl €26.00
(Delicata, Paola) 75cl €38.00

This gold medal winning full-bodied and robust Malta-grown Cabernet Sauvignon with a proven track record offers true classical varietal character derived from selected hand picked grapes. Described in WINE magazine as "A sweet, fruity nose, flows into a simple palate filled with light black fruits".

Italy

Nero d'Avola DOC Organic €24.00
(VivaBio Colomba Bianca, Sicily)

This wine is a brilliant deep red in colour. On the nose, aromas of ripe plum and black cherries are complemented by subtle floral notes of violet. On the palate, it shows good concentration and soft tannins, with a pleasant spiciness. This versatile wine pairs well with a variety of dishes, such as red meat, game, rich soups and salami.

Negroamaro €25.00
(Piantaferro, Puglia)

This wine features an intense, deep red colour with garnet shades. The bouquet reveals blackberry jam notes followed by a toasted sensation, including hints of coffee and cinnamon spices. The mouth entry is warm and enveloping, followed by a slight tannic note and a good persistence that leaves a dry mouth.

Cannonau di Sardegna €27.00
(Jerzu Bentu, Sardinia)

The Cannonau is the most important red grape variety of Sardinia. The Cannonau Bantu of Antichi Poderi di Jerzu is from grapes harvested around the village of Jerzu. It has a beautiful Mediterranean supplement and in addition to a lot of forest fruits, it also bears fine spicy notes.

Chianti Classico €33.00
(Banfi, Tuscany)

Banfi Chianti Classico is made from traditional varieties, predominantly Sangiovese. This wine has intense aromas of plum and blackberry jam. Fresh and balanced, this wine is perfect to enjoy with meat dishes.

Valpolicella Superiore €39.00
(Rocca Sveva, Veneto)

This elegant Valpolicella superiore is aged in oak cask for 10 months with an additional 4 months in bottles prior the release. This wine is medium to full bodied but softly textured with velvety dark fruit flavours and a flavourful finish accented with some sweet spice notes.

Barbera D`Alba Superiore Bricco delle Olive €49.00
(Palladino, Piedemont)

Aromas of toast, espresso, ripe berry and menthol lead the nose. The round, savory palate doles out juicy black cherry, blackberry, clove, chopped herb and game alongside chewy tannins. A coffee note closes the finish.

France

Pinot Noir €33.00
(Au Coeur des Terroirs, Loire Valley)

A wine made with grapes from clay-limestone soils of the Nantais vineyard. This terroir gives the grapes balance and complexity resulting in a fruity and ripe wine with the typical freshness of the Loire Valley

Côtes du Rhône Rouge Collection €34.00
(Domaine de Cristia, Rhone)

Beautiful bright garnet red with aromas of black fruits and wild herbs, elegant and well structured on the palate.

Saint Emilion €46.00
(Barton & Guestier, Loire)

An intense ruby red shade, this wine is dominated by fruit-driven aromas, particularly intense plum and blackberry notes. The wine is well-balanced with velvety tannins and a long, fruity finish.

Chateauneuf du-Pape Collection €85.00
(Domaine de Cristia, Rhone)

The wine has a deep red-cherry colour with a harmonious blend of floral and fruit aromas on the nose, with a subtle hint of liquorice. The palate is well-balanced with lively acidity and powerful, ripe tannins. The finish is long and intense with rich fruit and aromatic notes.

Spain

Rioja Crianza €33.00
(Carlos Serres)

The wine displays a cherry red colour with a brilliant purple rim. On the nose, there are mature red fruit aromas with a core of spice and subtle liquorice hints. The wine is well-structured and complex with a fresh and fruity character.

Chile

Cabernet Sauvignon Carmenere 'Limited Selection' €38.00
(Montes, Colchagua Valley)

This wine is a bright and intense purplish-ruby red colour with an expressive, perfumed nose which offers fresh aromas of red and black fruits, along with spicy notes of red peppers and nutmeg leading to tobacco, dark chocolate, and coffee. It is very well balanced on the palate, with rich acidity that turns fresh and juicy. The tannins are perfectly rounded and lend structure and volume. A sweet sensation increases toward the mid-palate, which leads to a long finish that is very much in accordance with the nose.

South Africa

Pinotage €22.00
(Arabella, Robertson)

Inviting aromas redolent of mocha & chocolate with elegant flavours of prunes, bananas & blueberries finishing with spicy undertones on the palate.

Australia

Cabernet Sauvignon 'All Rounder' €29.00
(Ian Botham, South Eastern Australia)

This wine has a deep ruby red colour with purple hues. The predominant aromas of blackberry and black cherry are combined with hints of ripe red cherry to give a well-defined varietal fruit profile that highlights the complex bouquet. Its well-balanced and fine grainy tannin adds complexity and a balanced finish with lingering distinctive fruit.

Argentina

Malbec Estate Reserva €36.00
(Kaiken, Mendoza)

Having a robust and lively violet colour, the predominant aromas are of blackfruit, with elegant notes of mint, coffee and chocolate, blending harmoniously with the oak. The wine is intense on the palate and very fruit-forward, yet delicate at the same time. It has excellent structure, smooth tannins and a long-lasting finish.

ROSE WINE

Medina Grenache D.O.K 37.5cl €15.00
(Delicata, Paola ~ Malta) 75cl €20.00

This is a delightful, aromatic, dry rosé blend made from hand-picked, Malta-grown red Grenache grapes, renowned for producing top-quality pink wines, blended to Cabernet Sauvignon. This delicious, slightly spicy rosé tastes of strawberries and fresh red summer fruits and shows real regional character.

Rose d'Anjou €25.00
(Calvet, Loire ~ France)

This rosé boasts a lovely salmon colour with pomegranate highlights. A fruity nose of strawberry, hazelnut and mint lends itself to being round, frank and fresh on the palate.

M De Minuty Rose €44.00
(Chateau Minuty, Cotes de Provence ~ France)

This blush wine is an instant hit with its intense aromas ranging from tangy berries to tropical fruit notes. It's vibrant and light on the palate with refreshing zesty and herbaceous notes.

DESSERT WINE

Moscato d'Asti 'Sciandor' €34.00
(Banfi, Piemonte ~ Italy)

This wine has a shiny straw-yellow colour and is enriched by a bouquet of aromatic scents that recall flowers, citrus fruits, candied fruits, and raisins. On the palate, the taste is delicate, sweet, and persistent, with a finish that highlights the fresh grape flavor.
